Sport Activities

Roller Skating:

Fridays 6-8 p.m. from September through May. \$2 admission charged to all skaters and non-skaters. Private skate parties are available. A two-hour party is \$25 for up to 15 people and \$1 per person over 15. Non-skating parents accompanying children will not be charged. Roller blades are not allowed. Youth are asked to stay in the building until time to return home and while waiting for their ride.

Gymnastics:

Membership is required to attend competitions and clinics. Cost of the card is \$36 - \$16 of the cost is paid by the Judo Club if the student participates in the Valentine Cake Sale in February. Judo giis (uniforms) may be checked out from the Center. Judo is coached by Rich Barlow, 3rd degree Black Belt. Permission forms are required.
